Education Programs

Shadows of the Fraser

K-3 • 1.5 hrs

Students get up close and personal with a shadow living deep in the Fraser: the white sturgeon. Discover the life of these elusive animals through songs, puppets, real life specimens and a fun, felt storyboard.

Living Dinosaurs

Gr. 4-7 • 1.5 hrs

Students explore the anatomy, life cycle and ecology of the white sturgeon. Through games and a conservation lab, students find out about the threats and current conservation efforts facing this unique and endangered fish.

The Trading Trail

Gr. 4-7 • 1.5 hrs

Students become archaeologists as they dig through the sands of the river uncovering artifacts that reflect BC's rich history. Students visit the FRDC trading post to discover the value of First Nations and European trade goods.

From Pollution to Solution

Gr. 2-5 • 1.5 hrs

Students are introduced to nonpoint source pollution using an interactive model of the Fraser River estuary. While exploring the experiences and efforts of those who raised awareness for sustainability, students discover the health of the Fraser River is in their hands.

Plants Alive!

Gr. K-1 or 2-3 • 1.5 hrs

*self-guided \$2 + hst per student;
adult supervisors free.

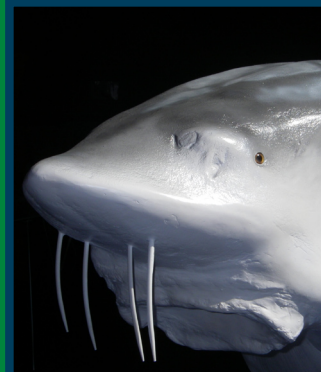
